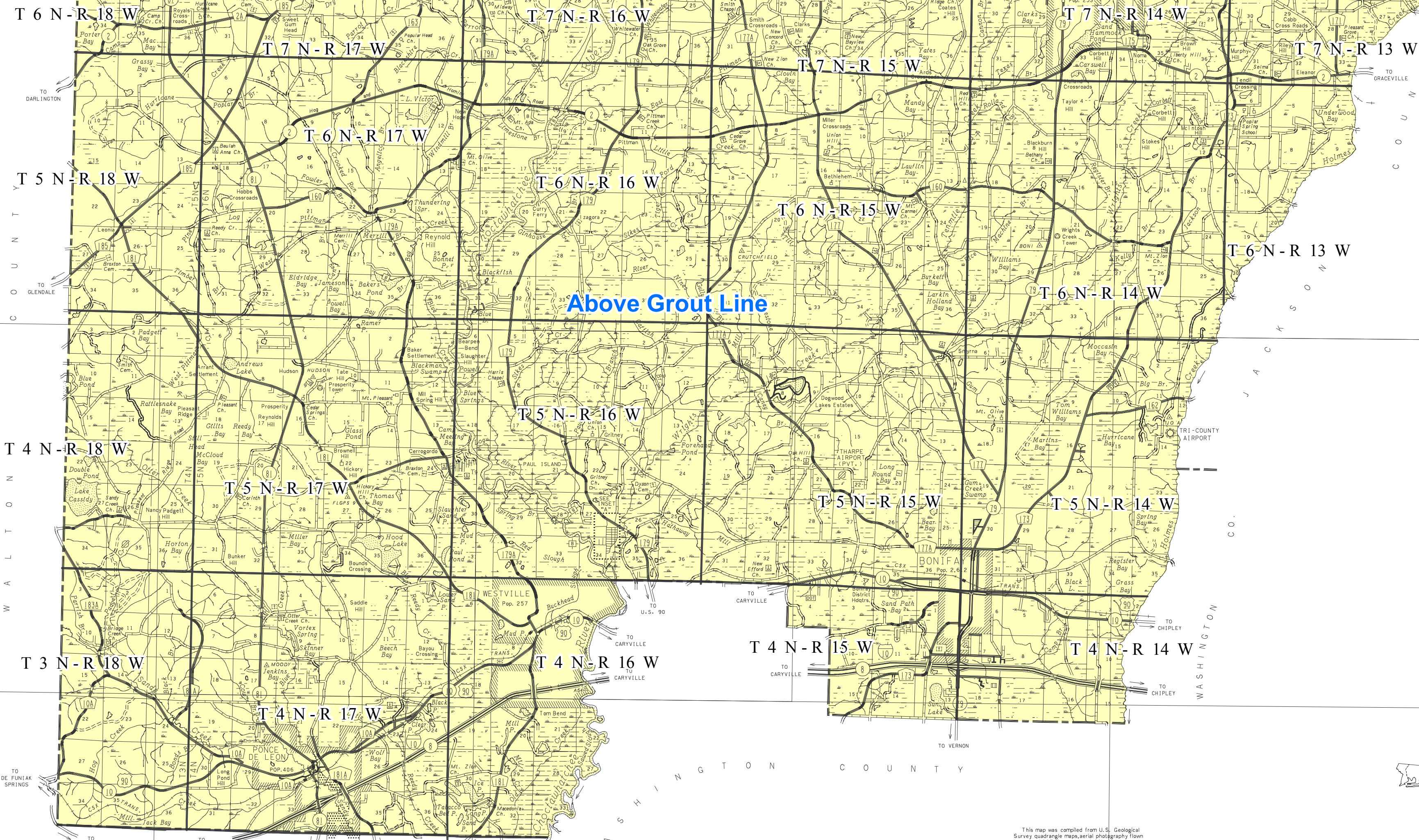
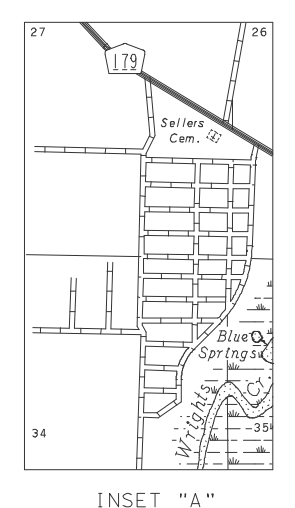




These maps are a visual representation of the District's groundwater regulatory features by county.



This map was compiled from U.S. Geological Survey quadrangle maps and photography from 1960 to 1990. General land office data, road inventory surveys Dec. 2000, and other data were used in the compilation of this map.

This map was compiled using interactive computer graphic techniques.

This map was prepared on the Lambert conformal conic projection, 1983 North American Datum, North Zone, Florida system of plane coordinates.

The railroad station symbol on this map does not necessarily denote the presence of a station or the facility. It may be also a point designated for the receipt or delivery of freight, such as a platform or siding.

In congested rural areas local roads are indicated by a single line only. If no data refer to a road, it is not shown.

No attempt has been made to show all drainage creeks and ditches.

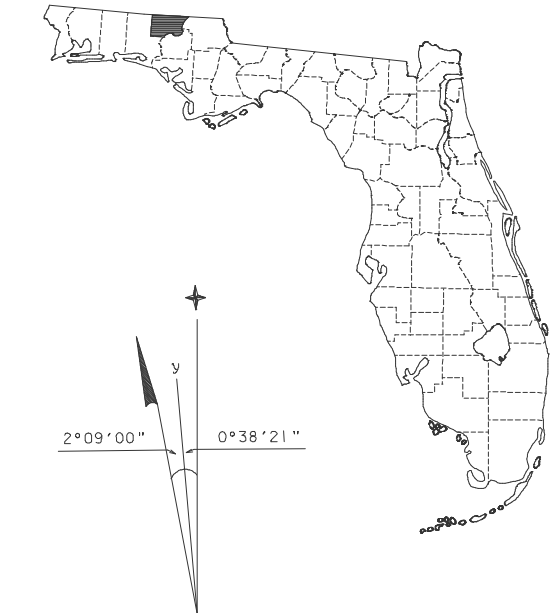
City populations are taken from the U.S. Census for 1990.

No claim is made for the basic cartographic source material taken from a work of the United States Government.

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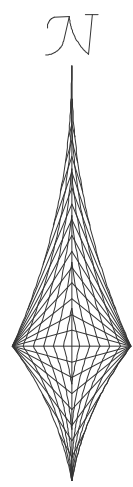

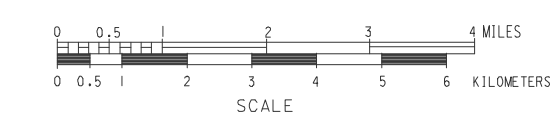
